



TGS Road Safety Program

The TGS Road Safety Program was initially established by the UN as a field-level intervention to access a standardised, first-class road safety training proven to reduce road crash risk – the leading cause of casualties in the aid sector.

Proven Training Methods

This is the only Program within the aid sector that focuses on developing and strengthening skills through knowledge transfer. The Program was designed to reduce road crash risks in low and middle-income countries specifically.

We use behavioural training methodology to transform negative driving behaviours into positive habits and to ensure drivers develop better awareness and a sense of responsibility.



Learning Portfolio

The two qualification courses delivered by TGS are Level 2 Advanced Safe Driver Training (ASDT) and Level 3 Qualified Driver Trainer (QDT). All courses can be offered using Soft-Skin and or Armoured Vehicles.



Quality Assurance

The Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents (RoSPA) has externally assured the training courses that make up the TGS Road Safety Program. This means that RoSPA experts have independently reviewed our methods, content, and processes apply to advanced behavioural driver training. These standards ensure they are relevant, pitched at the appropriate level and that the course will meet the highest standards for trainer competence and course quality.

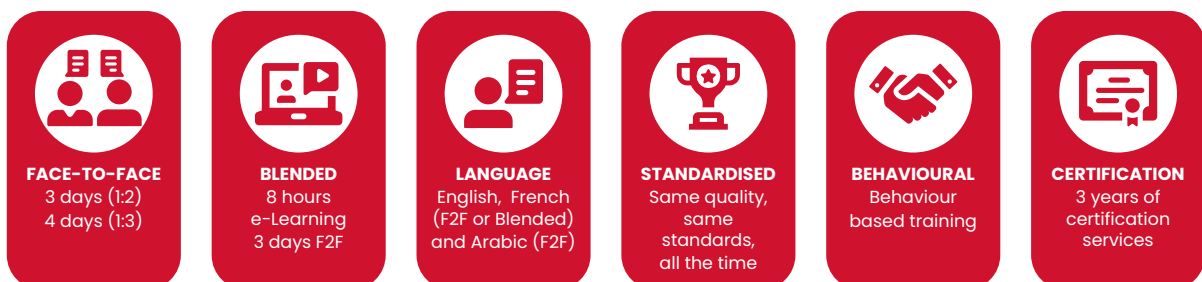

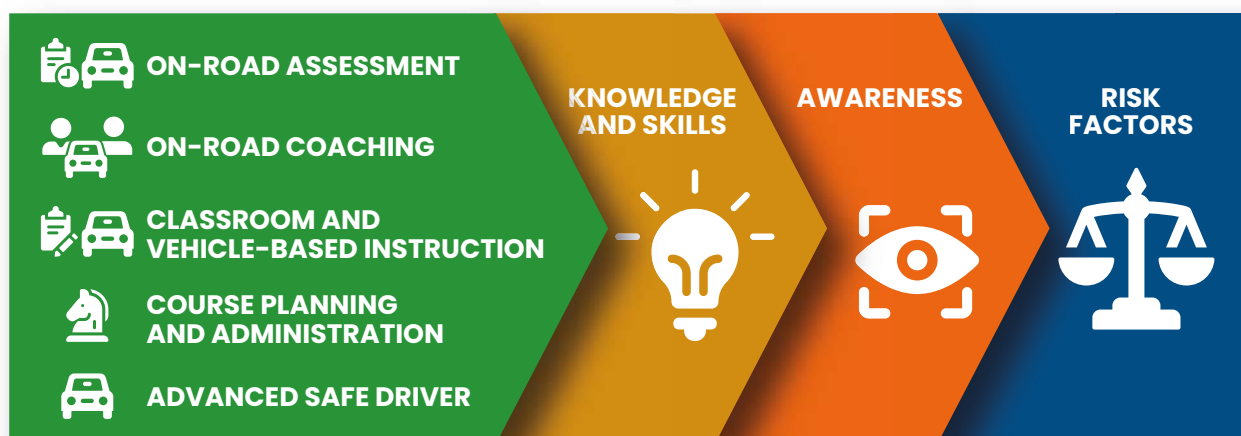


Level 3 Qualification: Qualified Driver Trainer
