Code of Conduct for GISF Event Attendees

At GISF, we are committed to fostering a welcoming, respectful, and inclusive environment for all attendees. This Code of Conduct applies to everyone participating in a GISF-run event, including attendees, speakers, exhibitors, sponsors, and volunteers.

By attending a GISF event, you agree to adhere to the following principles, which align with our values of trust, relevance, inclusion, and humanitarian principles.

1. Dignity and Respect

- You will treat all participants with respect and dignity, regardless of their background, identity, or beliefs.
- Harassment, discrimination, or any form of verbal, non-verbal, or physical abuse is strictly prohibited.
- Offensive or unwelcome comments based on gender, sexual orientation, race, ethnicity, religion, age, disability, or physical appearance will not be tolerated.
- You will refrain from distributing or displaying material that ridicules or shows hostility towards individuals or groups based on their identity.

2. Safe and Supportive Environment

- We prohibit any form of harassment, including sexual harassment. This includes unwelcome sexual advances, inappropriate comments, and any other conduct that may make someone feel uncomfortable or unsafe.
- Intimidation or sustained disruption of discussions or presentations is not acceptable.
- Violence or threats of violence, whether direct or incited, are strictly forbidden.

3. Legal and Ethical Conduct

- You will comply with all applicable laws and event policies.
- Engaging in illegal activities during the event, including the possession or use of weapons on event premises, is prohibited.

4. Cultural Sensitivity

- Please respect local customs and traditions if the event takes place in a different cultural or geographical setting.
- We expect attendees to remain mindful of their behaviour, particularly when interacting with local communities or individuals from diverse backgrounds.

5. Participation and Collaboration

- All participants are encouraged to engage in discussions in a collaborative and constructive manner.
- Disruptive behaviour that interferes with presentations, workshops, or group activities is not allowed.

Consequences of Misconduct

- Any violation of this Code of Conduct may result in immediate action, including the removal from the event without a refund.
- Serious offenses may also lead to reporting to relevant authorities or legal action.
